### **Middle School Program**

Learning for Life is a character education program that is used by teachers and administrators in their classrooms. Educators, administrators and parents from different ethnic, economic and social backgrounds developed the lesson plans. They are user-friendly and meet many of the Sunshine State Standards. They lesson plans supplement and enhance Pinellas County's Commitment to Character program that is used by all elementary schools.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Program:**

Includes 60 lesson plans for teachers to use in their classrooms.

Lesson plans are divided up into 9 sections that include: Respect, Responsibility, Honesty/Trust, Caring/Fairness, Perseverance, Self Discipline, Courage, Citizenship and Life Skills.

Each classroom receives an Honor Wall Chart that shows each student's progress with the program. Students earn stickers with each lesson plan they complete and can earn ribbons and certificates for displaying positive character traits.

### **7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Grade Programs:**

Includes 55 lesson plans for teachers to use in their classrooms.

Lesson plans are divided up into 6 units that include: Finding a Personal Direction in Life, Personality Traits and Personal Skills, Decision Making and Overcoming Obstacles, Strategies for the World of Work, Building Skills for a Lifetime and Examining and Building Relationships

There are also programs for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students that emphasize the importance of character education using guest speakers and workshops that teach students to prepare a cover letter, complete a resume, fill out an application and interview for a job.

The Learning for Life elementary program focuses on developing positive character traits in students using fun activities that are grade specific. These lesson plans also include take home activities that students can complete with their parents.
