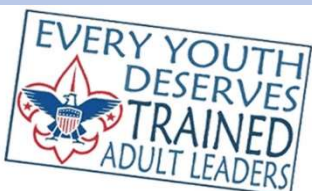

Youth Protection Training: Youth Protection training is required for all BSA registered volunteers and, along with a background check, is a registration requirement for leaders. Youth Protection training must be taken every two years. It is available at [My.Scouting.org](https://my.scouting.org).

Position-Specific (Role-Based) Courses: These instructor-led courses are designed to help Scouters learn how to effectively carry out their Scouting roles. In most cases, completing the course will make a Scouter “trained” for the role(s) covered in the course. Basic Adult Leadership Outdoor Orientation (BALOO): This one-and-a-half-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO training consists of an **online pre-requisite component in addition to an overnight hands-on practical**. BSA’s Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. **A MINIMUM OF ONE ADULT must be BALOO trained and present during any Cub Scout Pack overnight adventure.**

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS): Working as patrols, this hands-on two-night, two-day course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. **Along with Scoutmaster Specifics, this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Scouts BSA Troops in order to be considered “Trained”.**



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
