2. What is the specific date and time of your Court of Honor?
3. What is the full address where your Court of Honor will be held?
4. Would you like to have a Timucua District Eagle certificate?
5. Would you like to have a Timucua District Advancement committee member present a National Opening at your Court of Honor?

For each organization to be able to participate, we must have at least 2-3 WEEKS notice before the Court of Honor. Without proper notice, attendance is unlikely.
