Requirements for the King Pin Award

Award Definition: The award is given to someone who exemplifies Scouting. The award is open to any registered Scouter or non-Scouting adult who has gone above and beyond the call of duty to serve Scouting on a unit, district, council, or community level. The service done should be of an exceptional nature.

1. The award is administered by the Advancement Committee.
2. The **King Pin Award** can be presented to any registered Scouter or non-Scouter who has done **outstanding** work at any level of Scouting.
3. The award may be given four (4) times a year and will be considered by the District Committee in the months of March, June, September, and November. If no nominations are presented to the District Committee in these months, no award will be presented. A nomination will remain in effect until it has been presented to the District Committee three (3) consecutive times.
4. The award may be received only once.
5. The award cannot be shared.
6. The nomination must be made in writing, using this form.
7. The signature of three (3) registered Scouters is required on this form.
