



## Short Term Camp First Night Safety Brief

- **Welcome – Camp Director**
  - Introductions
    - Camp Director
    - Ranger
    - Health Officer
    - Other Key Volunteers
- **General Rules – Camp Director**
  - Be safe
  - Have Fun
  - Use the buddy system
- **Camp Status – Ranger**
  - Fires rules – what are the current conditions and what is allowed
  - Weather Status – Are we expecting it? Give emergency shelter locations
  - Any current Council Health and Safety Procedures
    - For example COVID procedures
  - Emergency Contact Information is posted around camp on signs
- **In the event of an incident / accident – Health Officer**
  - If life threatening
    - Call 911 first
    - Get someone to call health officer, camp director and Ranger
  - If not life threatening
    - Call Health Officer or Camp Director
  - Reporting the Incidents – Please help us complete them immediately
- **Camper Safety – Camp Director**
  - Everyone needs to have a completed health form – units may maintain them
  - Wrist Bands
    - Everyone at camp wears one
    - Tell which colors are campers, staff, etc.
  - Unknown person (without Band) – report to Camp Director or Ranger immediately
  - Check out procedure for supply runs or leave early
    - Sign out in log and sign in again
- **Reminder of Youth Protection Rules – Camp Director**
  - 2 Deep Leadership
  - No One on One Conduct
  - Buddy System – Adults are recommended too.
  - If you see someone with wrist band, contact the Camp Director or ranger immediately
  - If you see a YPT violation, contact Camp Director or ranger immediately
