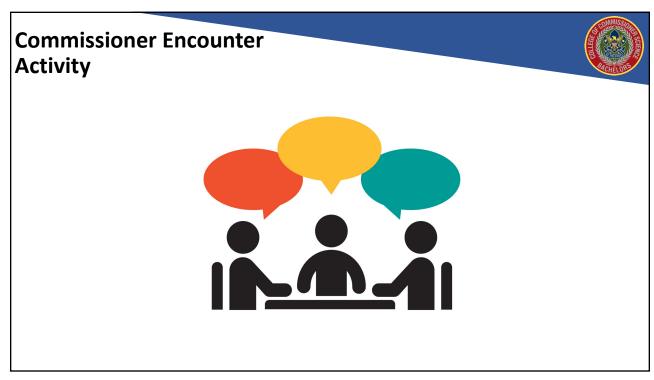

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Top 10 Relationship Characteristics



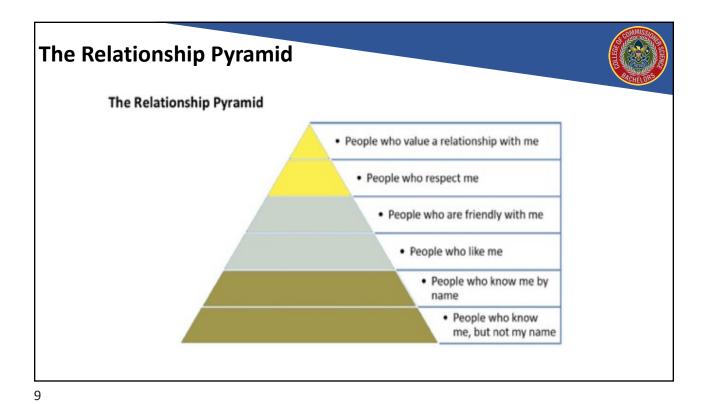
Reliable

Personal Interest



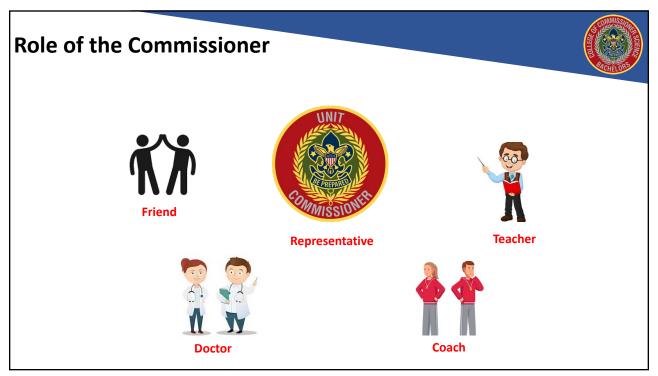

Rebuilding a Damaged Relationship



- Recognize what went wrong without assigning blame
- Be humble and explain simply and honestly what went wrong. If you need to apologize do it.
- Keep your word be open be genuine
